

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

A cumulative GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent in the courses required for graduation, as specified in subsection (1) of section 232.246, F.S., is necessary to graduate from high school.

At the end of each semester, the parent or guardian of each student in Grades 9-12 who has a cumulative grade point average of less than 2.5, will be notified that the student is at risk of not meeting the graduation requirements. This information will be noted on the student's report card.



NOTE: It is the responsibility of the student and his/her parents/guardians to ensure the student meets the graduation requirements and be aware of the factors that may effect his/her academic standing. It is the student's responsibility to notify his/her counselor of any errors, discrepancies or any anticipated problems. Your Guidance office is available to assist you in any of these matters.
