DIVERSIFIED CAREER TECHNOLOGY-ON THE JOB TRAINING (DCT-OJT)

Course #: 8300410

Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12

Course Length: One year (may earn as many as 6 credits a year while working in OJT)

Prerequisite: DCT teacher approval; concurrent enrollment in DCT Principles, DCT Applications, or DCT Management.

Students are paid while working in realistic on-the-job training program. Student must be at least 16 yrs. old.

DCT I PRINCIPLES

Course #: 8303010

Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12

Course Length: One year

Prerequisite: DCT teacher approval

Students learn employment training and career development. Basic computer technology skills with related multimedia software programs, employability skills, financial responsibility, life, and career goals are primary emphasis of this course.

DCT II APPLICATIONS

Course #: 8303020

Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12

Course Length: One year

Prerequisite: DCT I Principles

Students learn applications of job skills, employability strategies, environmental, health and safety issues, professional, legal and ethical responsibility, financial management skills, decision-making skills, leadership skills, and technology skills in the work place.

DCT III MANAGEMENT

Course #: 8303030

Grade Offered: 11, & 12

Course Length: One year

Prerequisite: DCT II Applications

Students plan, coordinate and demonstrate management-level skills. Students are taught the functions of management. Students are presented with business simulations that require decision-making skills as a manager. They learn how to assess employability skills, management/supervisory uses of technology
