

## PERFORMING/FINE ARTS ELECTIVES

These courses satisfy requirements for performing fine arts.

### **ART 2D COMPREHENSIVE I**

Course #: 0101300  
Grade Offered: 9, 10, 11, & 12  
Course Length: One year  
Prerequisite: None

Class provides a basic understanding and hands on approach to the elements and principles of design. These include, line, shape, form, color, and texture as it relates to 2-dimensional media. Students will learn the basics of drawing, painting, printmaking and mixed media. In addition, students will learn appropriate vocabulary, tools, techniques and skills related to the 2-D process.

### **ART 2D COMPREHENSIVE II/III**

Course#: 0101310/0101320  
Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12  
Course Length: One year  
Prerequisite: Art Comprehensive Design 2D I

Class provides more in-depth hands on work with drawing, painting and mixed media. Students will work with projects relating to 2 dimensional media, which includes pencil, pen, pastels, watercolors, and other various mixed media. These students will work in a more independent and advance fashion.

### **ART 3D COMPREHENSIVE I**

Course #: 0101330  
Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12  
Course Length: One year  
Prerequisite: None

Class provides a basic understanding of 3-dimensional media, which includes working with clay, plaster, cardboard and various other 3-dimensional materials. Students will learn the basic fundamentals of 3D design and the additive and subtractive methods of sculpture. In addition, students will learn appropriate vocabulary, tools, techniques and skills related to the subject.

### **ART 3D COMPREHENSIVE II/III**

Course #: 0101340/0101350  
Grade Offered: 10, 11, & 12  
Course Length: One year each  
Prerequisite: Art Comprehensive Design 3D I

Class provides more in-depth hands on work with the 3-dimensional media, which includes pottery, and other 3-dimensional materials and media. Mixed media projects will also be included. These students will work in a more independent and advance fashion.

### **GRAPHIC DESIGN I**

Course #: 0106300  
Grade Offered: 10,11, &12  
Course Length: One Year  
Prerequisite: Art 2D Comp I and teacher recommendation

Class provides the student with an understanding of the creative planning and execution of visual communication to convey a message. Students learn lettering, layout, and design and will work with a variety of media to design logos, letterheads, posters, and business cards.

### **GRAPHIC DESIGN II**

Course #: 0106310  
Grade Offered: 10,11, 12  
Course Length: One Year  
Prerequisite: Graphic Design I

The purpose of this course is to enable students to develop advanced skills in graphic design. Students will use graphic media, processes, and techniques to create images and products that demonstrate technical skills and aesthetic awareness, and reflect knowledge of the elements of art and principles of design.

Course Offered: 9, 10, 11, & 12  
Course Length: One year  
Prerequisite: None/Drama I and teacher approval

Includes an overview of the history of the theater and literature of the theatre. Students are introduced to the fundamentals of theatre production, which includes scenery, construction, costuming, lighting, and makeup. Students are introduced to the fundamentals of acting. Meets requirement for fine arts credit.
